### FAQ

- **Q: Is your school accredited?**
- **A:** No, we are the educational and training ministry of Amazing Grace Ministries which has a mandate to train, equip and mobilize believers for Cell Church Planting, Global Evangelism and Discipleship.
  
- **Q: How can my degree be used?**
- **A:** Our Degrees are recognized as the only recognized acceptable training for licensing, ordination by the Ambassadors Ministerial Fellowship and Christ Universal Church for our five-fold ministry positions.
  
- **Q: Will I receive a transcript?**
- **A:** Yes, you can order copies of your transcripts/permanent student records from a variety of our graduation packages.
  
- **Q: Can I order class rings?**
- **A:** Yes, we have a supplier for class rings from which you may order. The prices vary depending on the type of metal.
  
- **Q: Where are your classroom courses held?**
- **A:** Our classroom courses are held in what we call Network Training Centers in local communities both nationally and internationally. They may be held in worship facilities, schools, hotels, homes or wherever there is a need and a trained and qualified instructor available.
  
- **Q: Do you accept transfer credits?**
- **A:** Yes, but only for entry into our advanced level degrees. You must have completed at least 60 semester hours or have a Bachelors Degree in Ministerial Studies.
  
- **Q: Are my credits transferable to other schools?**
- **A:** You'll have to check with other institutions to see what their policies are?

- **Q: Do you offer licensing and ordination?**
- **A:** Yes, through the Ambassadors Ministerial Fellowship. You can visit their web site to apply for membership. [www.usamf.org](http://www.usamf.org)
  
- **Q: Do you assist with ministry opportunities?**
- **A:** Yes, we have many opportunities available for our graduates to serve in Cell Churches, Network Training Center and local, regional, national and international missions.

- **Q: What program can I start in and how do I pay my tuition?**
- **A:** You will start with the Associates Degree unless you have an advanced level degree in ministerial studies. You can pay as you go or pay full tuition by mail or online through PayPal.
  
- **Q: How long does it take to finish your program?**
- **A:** Students other than classroom, study at their own pace and may complete the Associates Degree in as little as 3 months or less depending on their study habits and how much time they have to devote to it.
  
- **Q: Can I call with questions if I have them?**
- **A:** Yes, we will be more than happy to assist you in any way possible
  
- **Q: What are your office hours?**
- **A:** Someone is usually available to make contact with you from 2:00pm to 6:00pm (EST) on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and from 10:00am to 1:00pm (EST) on Tuesdays.
